## **Application Notice PL94 – Meridian Seam Gas Project**

### **Resource activity: Site specific petroleum activity**

It is advised that Westside CSG A Pty Ltd has lodged an application for a major amendment to an environmental authority in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1994. The environmental authority being amended is EPPG00783713.

The application relates to amendments to existing conditions to increase exploration and production well intensity from 197 wells to 600 wells. Existing compression will also be increased from 7 ha across 7 compressor stations and 2900 kg / hour (total) to 15 ha across 7 compressor stations and 4200 kg / hour (total) fuel burning.

The resource activity is proposed to occur on the following tenure; Petroleum Lease (PL94). PL94 forms part of the Meridian Seam Gas Project and is operated as a joint venture between Westside CSG A Pty Ltd, Westside CSG D Pty Ltd (WestSide) and Mitsui E&P Australia Pty Ltd (MEPAU). The project area is located in the Moura-Theodore district of the Bowen Basin, Central Queensland.
